The Utah non-resident conceal carry course consists of one additional hour of class on Saturday and an additional \$49 fee to the state of Utah (payable by credit card or personal check on Saturday). We provide you with required fingerprinting, passport sized photo, mail the application in and provide a tracking number (one-stop shop all for \$60).

Utah will give you 9 additional states to be able to legally carry in. To take the Utah course, you must already have the Illinois license or take this Illinois class.

Please arrive a few minutes earlier on Saturday for registration so the class may begin on time. A FOID card is not needed for the class but you will need it before you apply for your Illinois CCL. NO firearms needed until Sunday.

On Sunday, you will need a firearm, and at least 35 rounds of ammunition. Please leave these in the car. In the afternoon, we will be heading out to Maple Park, by Route 47 and 38 for gun range and to complete certification.

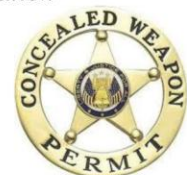
